

Expectations, Rules, and Guidelines

This is a home building/home repair ministry. All activities and energies should be focused to this end. You have made a commitment to the project. We expect each participant of our youth group to participate fully and meaningfully. In view of this, we have a few simple expectations from each member.

- **Due to the fact that we all need our sleep to do the best job possible, the following will be the rules for lights out.**
 - **10:30pm will start quiet time – no basketball, running around or outside.**
 - **11:00pm will be lights out in the bedrooms please be prepared for bed before that time.**
 - **1:00am will be lights out in the facilities – if someone is 20 minutes late getting ready, the next night lights out will be 20 minutes earlier for everyone.**
- Everyone will be expected to act responsibly the entire time they are in the community.
- Cell phones are allowed and encouraged on the trip and the work sites. We do require that at the worksite, devotional and sharing times that cell phones are put away and not used for texting, etc.
- Possession or use of drugs or alcohol is strictly forbidden. The ramifications of breaking this rule are severe. Anyone choosing not to abide by it will be asked to return home immediately.
- Firearms, air rifles or pistols, BB guns are not permitted.
- Smoking or use of tobacco products is prohibited at the church facility. Youth are not permitted to smoke anywhere.
- No pets are permitted.
- In order to ensure privacy of all participants, no females are permitted in the males' sleeping area or males permitted in the females' sleeping area, at any time.
- Youth will never be unattended. One adult will be with youth at all times.
- The use of audio equipment is strictly prohibited at the work site.
- Center attire: Discretion in clothing must be used at the center and in the community. Shirts must be worn at all times. When leaving the center grounds, walking shorts, Bermuda shorts and t-shirts will be acceptable attire. Halter or tank tops, Spandex clothing, bike pants, or shirts and hats expressing alcohol/beer slogans and/or obscenities are not acceptable. Jeans or pants are worn on the work site.
- **All volunteers (youth and adult) are expected to participate fully in the program. This includes attendance at meals, chores, meetings, evening gatherings, and any special events.**

Adult leaders reserve the right to terminate the participation of any individual if the individual does not abide by the rules and expectations.
